Netiquette Tips (Social Networking) for Children and Adults

Social media is an integral part of our lives. As adults, we need to provide guidance to our children to protect them. Included are social-networking tips from the link (<https://www.commonensemedia.org/blog/social-networking-tips>).

Parent Tips

- **Stick with age-appropriate sites.** For children 5-8, there are [sites with strong safety features](#) that help them play without risking inappropriate content or contact.

Parent Tips for Middle Schoolers

- **Facebook will not let children have sites if they're under 13.** Children can do the math to figure out what year to put so they'll seem 13 -- or older. **Check your child's computer browser history. If you see Facebook listed, assume your child has an account.**
- **Encourage your children to think before they post.** Remind them that everything can be seen by a vast, invisible audience (otherwise known as friends of friends of friends). Each family is different, but for middle school children, it's a good idea for parents to have access to their child's pages, to check on what's being posted is appropriate. Parents can help keep their children from doing something they'll regret later.
- **Set privacy settings.** Privacy settings aren't foolproof, but they're important. Take the time to learn how privacy settings work on your children's favorite sites, and teach your children how to control their privacy.
- **Kindness counts.** Many sites have anonymous applications like "bathroom wall" or "honesty boxes" that allow users to tell their friends what they think of them. Rule of thumb: If your children wouldn't say it to someone's face, they shouldn't post it.
- **Please continue to post positive posts about our school, staff, students or families.**
