Help Us Fill Flood Buckets!



The Lutheran Early Response Team, or LERT, is sponsored by the LCMS Disaster Response Ministry. These teams are trained to respond in the first critical days after a disaster.

The Holy Cross High School Youth are raising money to help supply a LERT team associated with Holy Cross as well as giving directly to the LCMS response to the floods in Baton Rouge. The purpose of this team is to have members trained in responding to disasters. The youth will create “flood buckets” which will contain needed cleaning supplies for distribution to those in need. Once the buckets are filled the team will have them ‘at the ready’ when disaster strikes.
