## This Week in Kindergarten...

### Bible Story

We: acted out the story of “Jesus Chooses His Disciples”. We, too, are God’s helpers! We can share His love and share the Gospel! **“Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men.” Matt. 4:19**

### Reading

We: reviewed letter “C”, identified same and different words, alphabetized letters, learned the K and C Spelling Rule, learned sight word “into”, and printed and read fun facts about KANSAS!

### Math

We: counted by 10’s to 100, counted dimes up to 50 cents, paid for items using dimes, matched numbers to sets, used pattern blocks, guessing and checking to problem solve.

### Social Studies
