This week in first grade, we:



Religion – listened to God's word. Our lessons were "Prophets Tell of a Savior" and "Jesus Heals a Crippled Man." We learned that God uses people to speak His Word, calling us to repentance and pointing us to Jesus. We also learned that Jesus graciously heals our spiritual blindness.

March's Memory Verse:

Reading – discussed and read stories about how animals survive in nature. The oral vocabulary words were: communicate, superior, survive, provide, wilderness. We worked with long o words with vowel spelling o, oa, ow and oe.

Math – practiced place value using dimes and pennies. We continued adding double-digits without regrouping. We also took a fact assessment.

Science – continued our unit on weather. We kept a daily record of the temperature and made prediction about the next day. We also add information in our interactive notebooks.
