Fun at School

Our classroom learned about Estimation this week. What does it mean? We estimated how many cubes it would take to fill up a letter Yy on a piece of paper. We had fun guessing. It took 22 cubes! This would be a fun exercise to do anytime at home. It does not take up much time, the children are practicing their counting, and they can come up with new ideas to estimate on their own. We really had lots of fun at Jog-a-thon Thursday. I was so proud of them! They ran and ran and ran for 30 minutes! Thank you for helping us to support our school projects with the Jog-a-thon event. We are talking about Palm Sunday in Jesus Time. This is the beginning of Holy Week. The children made a story sack about Palm Sunday. I hope they can share it with you. The story is written on the sack if you want to read it while your child acts out the story with the props they made. We had fun measuring with a yardstick, a 12 inch ruler and a 6 inch ruler. Reading those numbers is so important. Not all the children can recognize the numbers to 20, so we practice it often. We also had fun creating things out of ovals! We had some real good ideas! They thought of a face, flowers, animals, eyes, lollipops, tires, fried egg with yellow yolk inside, and shoes.
