This Week in Kindergarten...

Bible Story

We: acted “Mary Listens to Jesus”. We learned that listening to God’s Word is more helpful and important than anything! **“Blessed are those who hear the word of God and keep it!” Luke 11:28**

Reading

We: were introduced to the “combination qu” /kw/ sound, reviewed accents in words, learned sight word “what”, read Fluency Reader The Not Big Quilt, and alphabetized letter tiles!

Math

We: identified left and right, and were introduced to tangrams! We sorted them, identified them by “small, medium and large” shapes, and covered designs with them!

Social Studies

We: flew to Qatar, tasted hummus and esh asaryah (cheesecake), decorated a classroom quilt, played soccer (their favorite sport) and watched “Aladdin”. (Setting is similar to Qatar!)

Science

In our BUTTERFLY unit we: watched our caterpillars form chrysalides, watched the “metamorphosis” of a butterfly on youtube, acted out, stamped and wrote about the stages in it’s Life Cycle.
