DONATE YOUR SHOES TO 4 PAWS FOR ETHAN

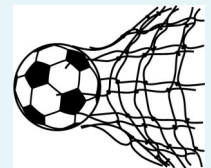

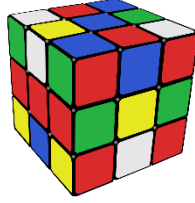
