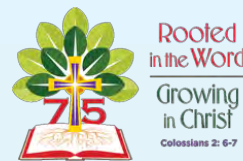

NOAH'S FLOOD

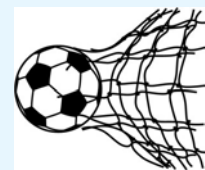
