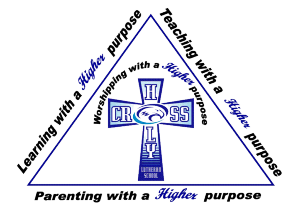
they knew we are Christians. This fear can lead to saying things that we regret. Children need to be encouraged to lay their fears and failures at the foot of the cross, let go, and let God.

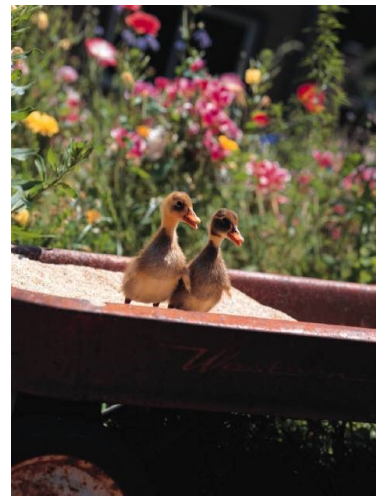


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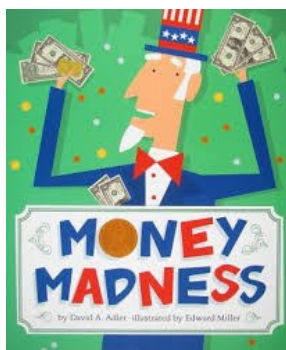
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MEMORY VERSE!! We're done!

not just about getting what we want but is what people use to buy things they need including services. The Life of a Dollar Bill, Money Madness, and King Midas and the

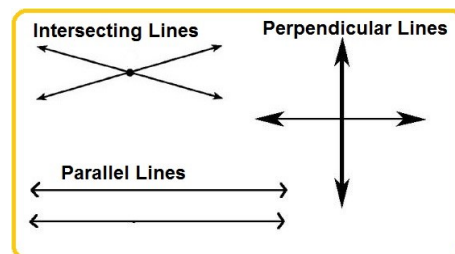
Golden Touch helped us to further understand the concept.

Math

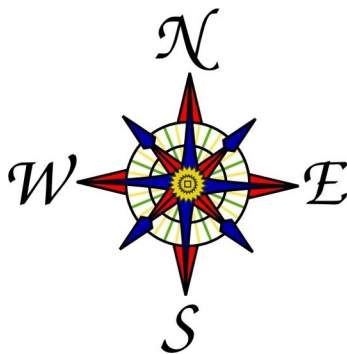
This week the children acted out, drew, and wrote number sentences for equal group stories (multiplication), identi-
