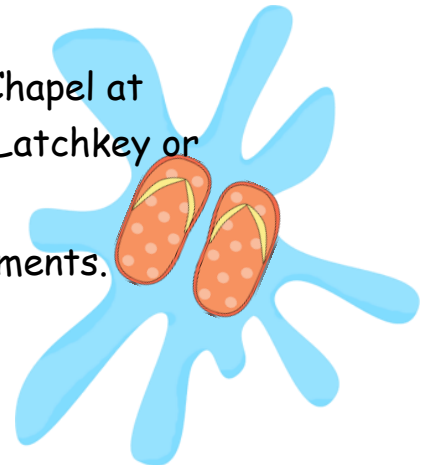
A packet of summer math papers is attached to the newsletter. Please use them for review and to help keep math skills sharp!
