## This Week in Kindergarten...

### Bible Story

We: read "God's People Cross the Jordan". God miraculously led His people into the Promised Land of Canaan. "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice." **Philippians 4:4**

### Social Studies

We: flew to Sweden, tasted kannebullar (cinnamon rolls), played "blindbock" (similar to Marco Polo), painted Dala horses. Soldiers carved these out of wood when they returned home! "Good Luck!"

### Reading

We: reviewed letter "S", identified final sounds in words, read from our 2nd decodable reader Hop on the Mop, worked with 2- and 3-letter blends, and introduced possessive apostrophes.

### Science

We: continued our Thanksgiving unit! We sequenced the growth of a corn plant, and then made tissue corn plants in Art class! We're re-learning how the Pilgrims and Wampanoag lived /worked.

### Math
