**Religion** - We began our study of the Miracles of Jesus. We studied the Bible lessons of "Jesus Heals the Paralyzed Man", "The Ten Lepers," "Jesus Brings a Widows Son to Life," "Jesus Stills the Storm," "Jesus Feeds the Crowd," and "Jesus Walks on Water."

**Math** - Students worked on subtraction math facts with 5's and 6's. Please continue to practice math facts daily at home. Students worked with problem solving strategies by solving problems by guessing and checking, worked with tangram pieces to cover designs in multiple ways, multiplied by 10, rounded to the nearest 10 and worked with base 10 blocks to help with understanding of two digit subtraction with regrouping.

**Library and AR** - May 3 will be the last day to check out library books and the last day of AR. Any student that has an AR book at home needs to have it returned by May 3. All library books will need to be turned in by May 10.

**Science** - Students did an animal experiment to find out how an octopus can use it arms and watched a video of an octopus opening a jar to get food. The science reports were FABULOUS! We learned so much about many different animals and we look forward to seeing these animals on our field trip on Monday to Tanganyika.
