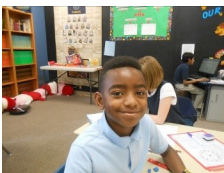
Math by Maddy

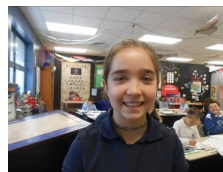
PE by Diamond

We read "Wildfires" and did a quiz over it. It was about how wildfires help.



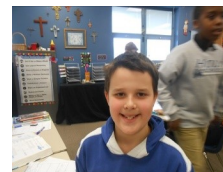
