Math - Students worked on multiplying by 5, telling time to the minute, adding three digit numbers, interpreting information from a graph, and subtraction with regrouping. Science - Students planned, designed, built, and tested a bug trap. They had a tremendous amount of fun! Students read about the scientific method: Question, Hypothesis, Test, Record Data, and Conclusion. Then they did an experiment to practice using the scientific method to find out if gravel, sand, or soil made the best imprint.

Field Trips - Tuesday, May 15, we will be going fishing! Kansas Wildlife and Parks will provide fishing poles, worms, and instruction in fishing. I am in need of parents, who are not afraid to touch fish, to come with us for this fun morning of fishing. We will fish for approximately 45 minutes to one hour.
