

First grade's homework is **READING!!!!** We are going to read, read, read! We are going to become **GREAT** readers!

Step 1 - Read



Today your child brought home two books that he/she needs to read orally to you. The children will bring these books home Monday through Thursday. The books should be returned to school as your child is finished with the book(s). Please have your child read the same book more than one night to help improve his/her fluency. Reading homework should take no more than 10 to 15 minutes per evening. If your child wants to continue reading after 10 minutes, he/she certainly may. Or, if you would like to finish reading the book after 10 minutes, that would be fine also. Enjoy reading with your child!

After you finish reading at night, have mom or dad sign your homework paper. I keep mine in my homework bag until it is time to turn it in at the end of the month.

Step 2 - Sign



Remember to have your child write the title of the book and you sign the homework sheet!!!! Even if you have already read the book the night before, write the title again and sign the sheet. This sheet will count towards their homework grade and as a bonus, they will automatically make their "BOOK-IT" reading goal!
