It's Book Fair Time again! We will be celebrating our reading "All Stars" with a sports-related theme. This time we are working with a local vendor, Eighth Day Books, to bring you a great selection of books for all ages. Book Fairs are a win-win situation for everyone: children get books they love to read; 20% of the total sales comes back to our school; and we can give the gift of books to those in need through the All for Books program.

The sale dates are **March 6-15** and it will be located in the south end of the Fellowship Hall. As always, we will be open before and after the worship services on both weekends. We will also be open during the KAIRS conference, Biz Kids, and Grandparents Day. See the complete schedule on the back of this page and look for the posters in the hallways.

The students will be able to preview the Book Fair on **Friday, March 6** and fill out wish lists of books and items that they want. These wish lists will be located at the fair near the cash registers if parents or grandparents want to shop without their student present.

We will also be participating in the **All for Books** program once again. This program collects donations from students and families that will then benefit a charity. This year, we are supporting the Guatemala Mission. To raise funds, we will be having a **Coin Challenge** the week of the book fair. Each day students are to bring in a different type of coin.
