This week in Kindergarten...

Bible Story

We: read and acted out "Joseph's Brothers Get Food in Egypt". Joseph went through hard times, but God used his circumstances for good! "For those who love God all things work together for good." Romans 8:28

Social Studies

We: flew across America, learned about some famous landmarks like the Statue of Liberty! (see above!) We painted fireworks, made and ate Regal Eagle cookies (our national bird) and printed red and white American words!

Reading
